French Coverage - 2025-2026

AIM	At St Margarets, we aim to instil a love of language learning for all children, decoding new vocabulary in a variety of ways. We follow the Kapow Scheme of Work, aligned with the KS2 MFL National Curriculum. Planning sequences follow a spiral curriculum, where topics feature a mixture of speaking, listening, reading, writing, grammar, language learning strategies and cultural references, designed to be taught in incremental steps throughout each year. Each lesson allows for pupils to develop accuracy with pronunciation through 'mouth mechanics' rehearsal and key teaching techniques for effective language learning. Pupils should build a strong foundation of French language for future study and experiences. Pupils should apply key vocabulary, phonics, and grammatical structures in a clear, sequenced way so that pupils can understand and express simple ideas with increasing accuracy and confidence. Through speaking, listening, reading, and writing activities, pupils learn to apply the French language in meaningful contexts and develop an appreciation of other cultures.
