Year 1 – Pentecost Term 1

English

This term, we're exploring a range of part of our **poetry writing**, we will be focusing on 'Oi Frog!', 'Take off your brave,' and 'Big red dragon.' As part of our **narrative writing**, we will be focusing on 'Madlenka' and 'Martha maps it out.' As part of our **letter writing**, we will be focusing on 'Paddington's Post,' 'Here Comes Mr Postmouse,' and 'Letters to A Monster.'

RE

This term, we are learning about **key events in Jesus' life** that help us grow in our Catholic faith, including:

- The cycle of the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ
- The road to Emmaus
- Promise of the Spirit and Ascension
- The work of Holy Spirit in our hearts
- Pentecost
- The mission of the Church begins at Pentecost

Science

This term we are learning about **Plants**.

Children will:

- Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

These include learning about:

Spring, plants, garden plants, wild plants, trees and parts of a plant.

Maths

This term, we're focusing on '**multiplication and division**.'

Children will learn:

- Multiplication and division: equal or unequal groups and remainders
- Multiplication: repeated addition and arrays (number of groups and size of group)
- Multiplication: problem solving (identifying the number of groups and size of the group)
- Multiplication: scaling and counting in 2s to 24
- Division: sharing and grouping problems

History

In History, we are learning about **castles**. We are exploring why castles were built, what life was like inside them, and how they were used in battles. We will also learn how castles have changed over time, what they are like today, and discover the famous Tower of London.
