A Message from Bishop David



Dear young friends in Christ,

The Sacred Triduum sounds a mouthful doesn't it? It refers to the three most important days of the year for us, disciples of Jesus. Indeed, these are the most important three days in the whole history of the world! First of all, on Holy Thursday we remember the moment when Jesus washed his disciples feet and celebrated the Passover Feast with them. During this sacred banquet, Jesus gave us the gift of his own Body and Blood. Imagine that, when we receive Holy Communion at Mass, Jesus is making his home with us in the best way he knew how to do so. Remember how Jesus prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane. He was frightened just like any of us when faced with something so challenging as he is suffering on the Cross. Then, without having to and freely choosing to, Jesus is obedient to the Father's will and is arrested. He is led away.

On Good Friday Jesus is falsely accused. Jesus must carry his Cross to a place outside of Jerusalem, and he suffers and dies so that we can enter heaven at the end of our lives here on earth. And then we think of the resurrection on Easter day. It is difficult for us to imagine what exactly happened at Easter. But this is what it means for me. When Jesus died, all my sins, my fears and worries, they also died. Because of the resurrection, I am filled with so much hope and joy. Nothing in this world can rob me of the joy of knowing that God's glory is at work in our lives today. He has poured out that same Spirit on me, a Spirit of life, which raised Jesus' dead body to unending life. Wow, what a powerful three days these are in the history of our world!

Have a lovely Easter and don't forget to say thank you to Jesus for all he endured for us.



Three days - the high point of the whole Christian year



Good Friday



On Good Friday, the soldiers placed a heavy wooden cross on Jesus shoulders.

Jesus carried his cross and when he got to the hill of Calvary the soldiers nailed him to the cross.



From the cross Jesus prayed:

'Father forgive them they don't know what they are doing' (Lk. 23.34)



Then Jesus said:

'Father I give myself to you'

and he bowed his head and died. (Lk. 23.46)

We call this day good because it was the day that Jesus died for us, so that we could have new life in him.



Jesus died that we could live. He changed the cross of shame into a sign of victory over death.



When we go to church on Good Friday we kiss a wooden cross.

This is a sign that we want to remember how much Jesus loved us by dying on the cross for us.

We thank you that Jesus gave his life for us to save us from sin and death.


Make us strong to show your love where ever we may be .

We celebrate our passing from sin and death to new life in the risen Lord


The celebration in Church on Holy Saturday begins in darkness. The Easter candle is lit and we sing

The final part of our celebration on Holy Saturday is to receive holy communion.




