Year 1 – Lent Term 2

English

This term, we're exploring a range of texts. As part of our **rules and recount writing**, we will be focusing on the books called '**Ravi's Roar**' and '**Ruby's Worry**.' As part of our **poetry writing**, we will be focusing on '**Oi Frog!**,' '**Take off your brave**,' and '**Big red dragon**.' As part of our **narrative writing**, we will be focusing on '**Madlenka**' and '**Martha maps it out**.'

RE

This term, we are learning about **key events in Jesus' life** that help us grow in our Catholic faith, including:

- Jesus is tempted in the desert & Ash Wednesday
- Jesus enters Jerusalem and Jesus teaches in the temple
- The widow's mite
- The Last Supper
- The Crucifixion and death of Jesus
- The angel's message

Science

This term we are learning about **Materials**.

Children will:

- Distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made.
- Identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock.
- Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.
- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials based on their simple physical properties.

Maths

This term, we're focusing on '**addition and subtraction**,' and '**number, place value and measurement**.'

Children will learn:

- How to calculate the unknown part or whole
- Problem solving
- Comparing numbers up to 20 (difference, more, less, fewer)
- Coins and combinations to 20p
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Measures: non-standard measures and introducing simple standard measures

Geography

This term, we are learning about the **United Kingdom** (UK) and the countries in it. We will explore tourism and landmarks of the UK and investigate capital cities.
