**Year 3 – Pentecost Term 2**

## English

Children will be writing a non-chronological report using captions, headings, subheadings, prepositions, alliteration, lists and expanded noun phrases.

They will also write a narrative focusing on story structure and the use of dialogue.



## RE

**Choices** - Children will learn about the importance of making good choices and that all actions have consequences. They will learn more about the Sacrament of Reconciliation and its importance.

**Islam** - Children will also briefly learn about a different faith.

**Special Places** - Children will learn that the Christian community has many special places: places where people gather for prayer and worship; places are holy because of their association with Jesus or holy people and become places of pilgrimage.

## Science

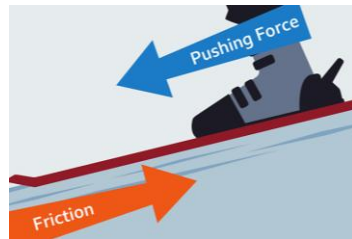
### Forces

Children will learn some forces need contact between two objects, but magnetic forces can act at a distance.

Force is required to make something move.

The heavier the object the more force is required.

They will compare how different surfaces effect forces in motion.

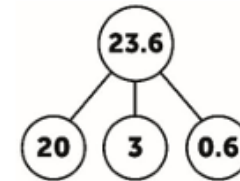


## Maths

Children should be logging into [Times Tables Rock Stars](#) daily and playing for a minimum of 15 minutes. Login details can be found in the front of your child's reading record.

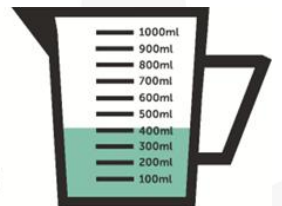
In Pentecost 2 the topics we will be covering are:

- Time: duration
- Securing the four operations with whole number including problem solving
- Place value and decimals: ten times greater and ten times smaller
- Place value and decimals: regrouping
- Place value and decimals: estimation, comparing and rounding
- Measures: measuring and problem solving
- 3-D shape: building and identifying properties



There are ten groups of 100ml in 1000ml (1l).  
100ml is 1 tenth of 1 litre.  
100ml = 0.1l

400ml is 4 tenths of a litre so 0.4l



Children will be given Maths homework to consolidate the learning from that week on a Friday.

## History - The changing power of the British Monarchy

Children will learn that:

- King John signed the Magna Carta; introducing rules of monarchy.
- Henry VIII started the Church of England, removing ties with Rome.
- Queen Anne reigned and supported the Act of Union, 1707.
- Queen Victoria showed power of her rule through her portraits.
- Queen Elizabeth II was the longest reigning monarch of England.
- King Charles III is the current King of UK and reinforces the values of faith, hope and love, to the future of the world.

The power of the monarchy has shifted from absolute power to constitutional power today.
